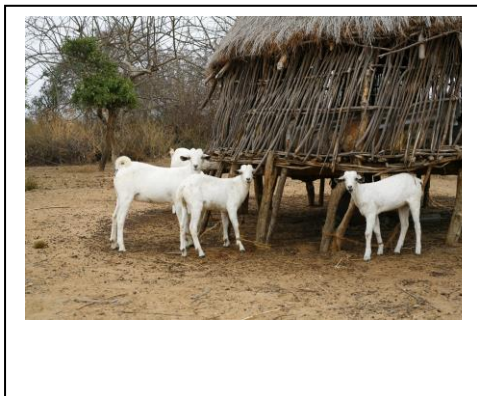
KS1 – Education and Girls

Her job is to look after these goats.

Like 31 million other girls, Sefiyat does not go to school.
It is not safe for her to cross this river.



Instead of going to school, Sefiyat helps at home.
She washes clothes and plants sweetcorn in the fields.
